



Floor Tech/Custodial Service

Interested in earning your Floor Tech/Custodial Certification?

The Floor Tech/Custodial is an 8-week program that trains participants in both contemporary and traditional floor care techniques such as stripping and waxing, buffing, tile and floor restoration, upholstery cleaning, safe handling and mixing of chemicals and certifications as a general custodian and/or floor technician.

Forklift Training

Train to become a certified forklift operator and find a new career in a high-demand field.

Transitional jobs program to help non-custodial parents

Our Apartment Maintenance Tech Program will turn your skills into opportunities through credential training as a Maintenance Technician. You must have previous work experience in the area of construction or mechanical maintenance for the 7 week training program. Participants will work along side residential technicians during the training process and once you have completed the program requirements job placement assistance is provided.
