



Logistics and Supply Chain Management

PROGRAM

The key skills attained by program participants for logistics positions are customer service principles; computer software proficiency (such as spreadsheets, email and GPS); and an understanding of basic shipping methods, warehousing and tracking systems.




Youth Employment Services (Y.E.S.)

PROGRAM


College Career Catalyst (C³)




